

How to Schedule Legal Visits with People Detained in ICE Custody in Oklahoma

Diamondback Detention Facility (Watonga, OK)

- Create and activate an ERO eFile Account through ICE's website:
<https://www.ice.gov/eroefile>.
- File G-28 with <https://eroefile.ice.gov/eroefile>.
- List your client's name and A-number, and at that point you should be able to set up visitation.
 - Note that you must upload your ID and bar card every time. While the Diamondback website recommends emailing diamondbacklegal@corecivic.com, local practitioners have had more success scheduling visits through the ERO eFile link above.

Cimarron Correctional Facility (Cushing, OK)

- Email cimarronvisitation@corecivic.com with your G-28, bar card, ID, and a request to schedule an appointment either by phone or in person. They will not permit you to visit on weekends.

Kay County Detention Center (Newkirk, OK)

- While the Kay County Detention Center's website states that attorneys can schedule visitation through the above ERO eFile link, local practitioners have had more success emailing vtc.assistant@kaycountycdc.net.

David L. Moss Criminal Justice Center (Tulsa, OK)

- Local practitioners have had success by simply calling the jail to schedule an appointment.
- Note that David L. Moss is in the Northern District of Oklahoma. As such, any habeas petitions must be filed in the District Court for the Northern District of Oklahoma according to their local rules.
