

What does HB 1775 mean for teachers?



A quick guide to what Oklahoma K-12 educators can and cannot teach.

Teachers can still teach:

- Historical events
- Public figures & their beliefs
- Social theories
- Public policy
- Oklahoma Academic Standards topics

As long as they do not
teach prohibited concepts
as factually correct.

What does that look like?

ALLOWED

“ In 1921, a violent mob of white people burned and looted Black-owned businesses in Tulsa...”

NOT ALLOWED

“White people should feel guilty about the Tulsa Race Massacre.”

Teaching about a topic is not the same as endorsing it.
